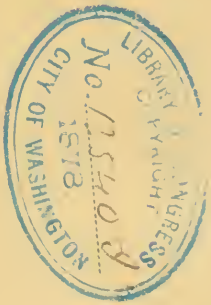


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T A B L E

OF THE QUANTITY OF CLOTH USED IN MAKING MEN'S GARMENTS.

COATS—Single or Double Breasted

Frocks and Cut-Away Coats.

Of goods 27 inches wide—4 yards and $4\frac{1}{2}$ yards for men of short or medium figure. 5 to 6 yards for stout or very large stature.

Single or Double-Breasted Sack Coats.

$3\frac{1}{2}$, 4 and 5 yards, according to size.

Sack or Frock Overcoats.

For medium, 5 yards, 27 inches wide, or $2\frac{1}{2}$ double fold.

For stout, $5\frac{1}{2}$ yards, 27 inches wide, or $2\frac{3}{4}$ double fold.

Ulsters.

1 yard single, or $\frac{1}{2}$ double, more than for overcoat.

PANTS.

For short men, $2\frac{1}{2}$ yards, 27 inches wide.
“ medium “ $2\frac{3}{4}$ “ “ “
“ stout “ 3 to $3\frac{1}{2}$ “ “ “

VESTS.

Single and double-breasted vests require $\frac{3}{4}$ to $1\frac{1}{4}$ yards, 27 inches wide.

MORNING COWNS.

Medium Length, $4\frac{1}{2}$ to 5 yards, 27 inches wide.

BREAKFAST JACKETS.

3 to $3\frac{1}{2}$ yards, 27 inches wide.

LADIES' CLOAKS AND ULSTERS.

Sack style, short, $1\frac{3}{4}$ double fold goods.

“ “ long, 2 to $2\frac{1}{2}$.

Ulsters, $2\frac{1}{2}$ to 3 yards.

Walking Coats, $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 2 yards.

Long Circulars, $2\frac{1}{2}$ yards.

Short Talma, $1\frac{1}{2}$ yards.

Long Talma, $2\frac{1}{2}$ yards.

TRIMMINGS.

Dress Frock Coats or Cut-Away

Frocks.

- 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards Italian cloth (satin de chine) 30 in. wide.
- 2 $\frac{1}{8}$ " sleeve lining, 40 inches wide.
- 1 " canvas.
- 3 " black silesia, for pockets.
- 4 " brown holland.
- 4 " thin, unbleached cotton for covering wadding.
- 3 sheets wadding.
- 5 buttons for single-breasted coats—8 for double-breasted.
- 6 skeins silk, or 1 spool machine twist.
- 1 skein thread.
- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards twist.
- 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards braid.

Pantaloons.

- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard pocketing.
- 12 inches holland.
- $\frac{1}{4}$ yard silesia for band linings and fly.
- 6 large and 6 small buttons.
- 3 skeins silk or 1 spool, 1 skein thread, 1 buckle.

Vests.

- $\frac{3}{4}$ yard black silesia.
- 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " light colored silesia.
- 1 $\frac{1}{8}$ " holland.
- $\frac{3}{4}$ " vest padding.
- 2 skeins silk and buttons.

To line a Boy's Coat requires twice the length.

For Overcoats it takes 5 to 8 yards of Braid.

Jackets or Sack Coats require 4 to 6 yards of Braid.

Morning Gowns.

Linings of flannel or other material, 27 inches wide, 5 yards. BREAKFAST JACKETS, 4 yards.

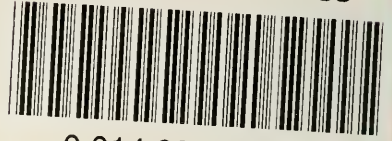
